**Enhancing Environmental and Ecological Awareness and Education in Schools:
Training Teachers on the Use of Web2.0 tools and Open Educational Resources**

The school will focus on a training course with lectures and practical sessions (hands-on labs) on the World Wide Web and its educational uses for teachers and discuss strategies for searching information and educational material online. It will also show how to prepare, upload and share open educational resources as well as the way these can be organized in personal e-portfolios and can be found online in learning portals.

In addition, the school will deal with social metadata and Web 2.0 tools (folksonomies & social tagging), while at the same time present popular social tools and scenarios for their use in the classroom. Lastly, pedagogical strategies, scenarios and best practices for using digital teaching & learning resources for environmental/ecological education will be demonstrated and case studies connecting/combining different curriculum topics with environmental/ecological education will be presented.

If interested, you may receive a grant from your Comenius National Agency in order to cover all expenses to attend this course.
